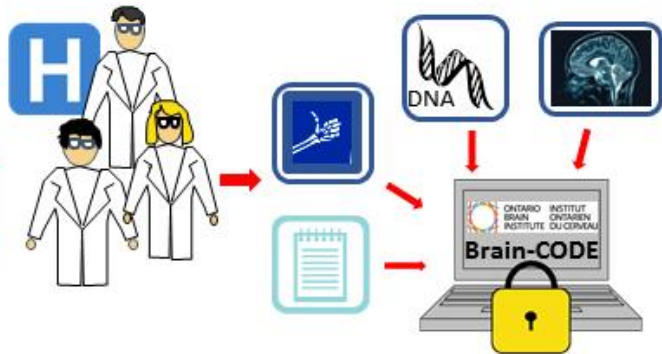

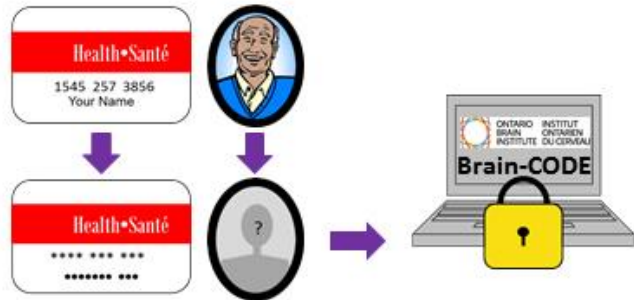
Collecting Your Data

Researchers will collect your data during the study and store it in Brain-CODE, a databank created by the Ontario Brain Institute.



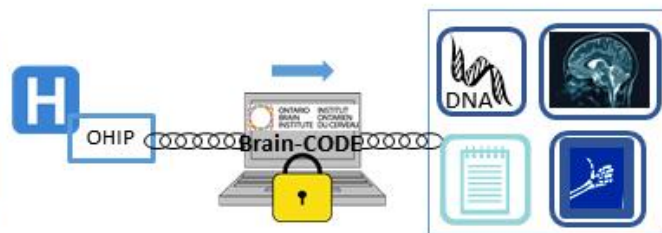
Protecting Your Data

Your health card number will be encrypted and information that can be used to identify you will be removed before any data is shared. This information will be stored safely and securely in Brain-CODE.



Enriching Research Data

This safe and secure data may be used to link with data from other databases, such as OHIP, to allow for richer data sets.



Who Can See Your Data?

Once identifying information has been removed, your data may be shared with local, national and international researchers and organizations that are not part of this study. If third parties are interested in specific data sets, they must first apply to a Research Ethics Board and provide a detailed plan before they can see the requested data.
